

#### Use of Pupil Premium Funding 2015/2016

There are currently 73 students registered as having been on FSM within the last 6 years. Our "FMS ever 6" students make up 49% of the population. The government allocates extra money to our schools – Pupil Premium Funding. This funding is allocated to raise the attainment of FSM students and close the gap in attainment between FSM and non FSM students.

Due to the numbers of students in receipt of FSM we were allocated the following amount of pupil premium funding:

#### **Pupil Premium Allocation**

In line with our School Development Plan to raise attainment of FSM students, we are allocating funding for September 2015 – August 2016 to the following areas:

SEN staffing: Staff work with Pupil Premium Students across all departments. Teaching Assistant allocated to work with SENCO.

**Cost £52,100**

Introduction of CAT 4 /Boxhall Profile: Assessment of Pupil Premium Students to identify and ensure they reach their expected levels of progress.

**Cost £2,500**

Rewards System: Provides incentives for improving attendance, punctuality and achievement.

**Cost £5,750**

Literacy & Numeracy Resources: The school has invested in additional resources to support literacy and numeracy across the school targeting Pupil Premium Students with lower abilities.

**Cost £1,000**

Motivational Speaker: The school has invested in motivational speaker sessions to raise attainment and to inspire students

**Cost 4,000**
