Here at St Thomas's it is our desire for all our students to achieve their full potential. We understand in order to succeed our students may require extra support and encouragement as they approach the final stages of their GCSE's. Therefore, St Thomas's have developed an intervention plan to support all Year 11 students in both North and South Provisions.

Some students will receive intervention during the normal school timetable in pathway lessons and some on a 1:2:1 basis depending on the needs of the individual student. In addition to personalised intervention each provision will be offering intervention classes each week.

We would be grateful if you would collaborate with school by encouraging your child to not only work to their full potential in the final seventeen weeks of their GCSE's, but also to access the intervention classes available after school in order to make the most of the opportunities offered to them in each provision. Both Teachers and Teaching Assistants will be available during these intervention classes to assist students with either English/Maths/Science/ICT. Finally, there will be a Revision Guide presentation for parents in March, a letter will be sent out nearer the time with further details.
