



## Cookies usage policy

### **Our Cookies Policy**

We use cookies and similar technologies on this website to improve performance and enhance user experience. This policy explains how we do that.

### **What are cookies?**

Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you visit a site or page. The cookie will help you website, or another website, to recognise your device the next time you visit. Web beacons or other similar files can also do the same thing. We use the term “cookies” in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this way.

### **What sort of cookies does our website use?**

Generally, our cookies perform several different functions:

#### **Performance Cookies**

These cookies allow us to collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors visit most often and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't record information that personally identifies a visitor.

All information these cookies record is aggregated and anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works. By using this website you agree we may place these types of cookies on your device, unless you have disabled.

#### **Functionality Cookies**

These cookies allow a website to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language or region you are in) and provide enhanced, personalised features. These cookies can also be used to remember changes you have made to text size, fonts and other parts of web pages that you can customise. They may also be used to provide services you have asked you have asked for such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies record may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing

activity on other websites. By using this website you agree we may place these types of cookies on your device, unless you have disabled them.
